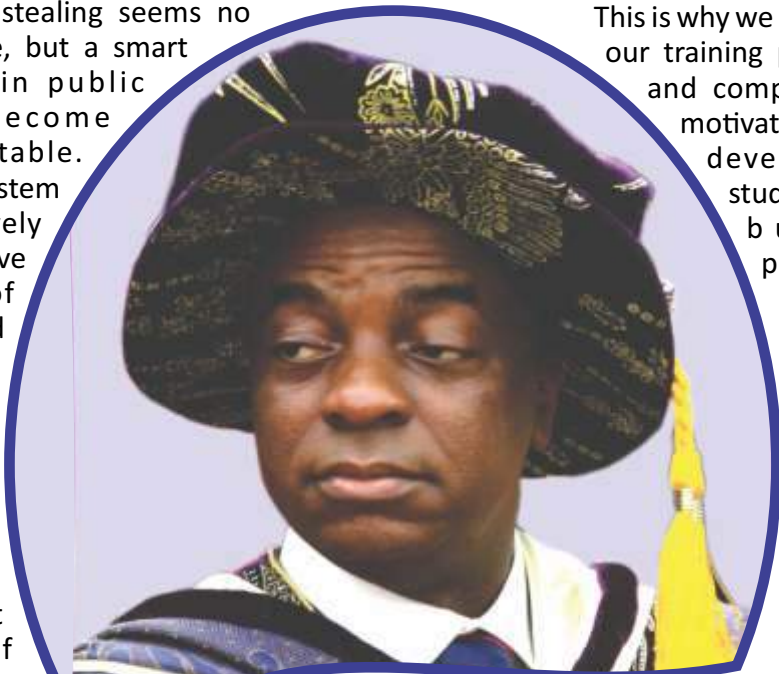
This is why we have remained resolute in our training process. Our clear vision and compelling missions are the motivators of our commitment to developing the wit of our students through our custom-built University programmes.

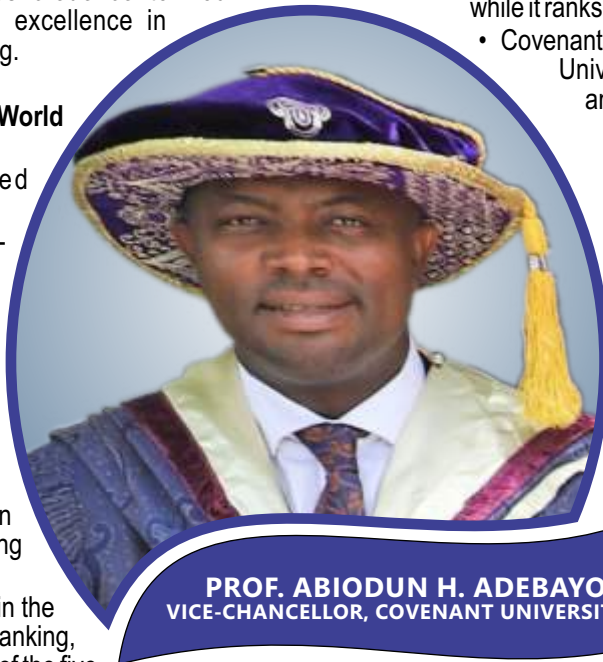
VICE-CHANCELLOR'S WELCOME WORD

The Solution17 for Climate Action in Africa, a joint project of Covenant University and Creative Youth Community Development Initiative, was birthed to spark creativity among young people in building the "Future We Want through Climate Action." The project explores students and youths' creative and innovative capacities through a proper understanding of sustainability, their environment, and the current global threat (COVID-19); to produce Sustainable Development Goals (SDG)-based solutions for social impact and profit. The practice is expected to promote entrepreneurship, start-up development, innovation, and a green economy.

Covenant Wins Africa's Most Impactful Quality Education University of the Year 2021



Covenant received the Africa's Most Impactful Quality Education University of the Year 2021 award. The African Brand Leadership Merit Award conferred this Award on the University in recognition of her leadership, innovation, and creativity in the education sector in Africa.

Covenant Receives Africa's Best World Class Quality Education Private University of the Decade Award

The Award Committee for the 7th African Quality Achievement Awards selected Covenant as winner of the 2021 "Africa's Best World Class Quality Education Private University of the Decade". The award was initiated by The Africa Quality Institute.

National Universities Commission Re-accredits Covenant Programmes

This year, the National Universities Commission (NUC) accreditation teams visited for reaccreditation exercises for some of our undergraduate and postgraduate programmes by an assessment of the compliance level with the NUC BMAS. All five postgraduate programmes (Accounting, Banking & Finance, Business Administration, Industrial Relations and Human Resource Management, and Marketing) returned with "full accreditation status." All the eleven undergraduate



programmes assessed, were re-accredited.

Covenant University Tops School Choice in 2021 UTME

The Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board (JAMB) noted that five of the top ten candidates in the 2021 Unified Tertiary Matriculation Examination (UTME) including the overall best candidate chose Covenant University as their first choice. In the Best Engineering Graduate Award category, Covenant's Ezeudji Daniel (Best Engineering graduate of 2020 class) came 2nd.

Covenant University Wins at 3rd CU Invitational

Covenant University emerged as the overall Champion and Best Speaker respectively at the third edition of the Covenant University Invitational tournament, which had university students from among twenty universities worldwide compete in British Parliamentary-style debate and public speaking.



Covenant Alumna Wins 2021 NYSC Essay Competition

Miss Peace Akhibi, a 2020 First-Class graduate of Covenant University emerged winner of the 2021 National



Youth Service Corps (NYSC) Essay Competition. The organisers of the competition received a total of 96 entries from corps members nationwide.

Covenant Wins International Sustainable Campus Network Excellence Award

The PET CITY BRICKS, a project submitted by Covenant University Enactus, was selected as a winner of the 2021 International Sustainable Campus Network Excellence (ISCN) Awards in the 'Whole Systems Approach' category. The entry was selected as a project that exemplifies the principles of the ISCN, and an outstanding example of excellence in this category. The Covenant Enactus Pet City Bricks had previously won the Enactus Nigeria National Competition in 2019 and 2020 respectively as well as the Professor Ayodele Awojobi Design Competition in 2020. ISCN Awards, which began in 2009 had been won by prestigious and high-ranking universities in the past. Covenant University became the first University in Africa to win this award.

Covenant Bags Gold Medals at 2020 World Invention Creativity Olympic

Products of Covenant University won gold medals at the World Invention Creativity Olympic (WICO) in 2020. This was organised by the Korea University Invention Association in Seoul, South Korea.

Covenant Receives Excellence in Quality Entrepreneurship Education Award

This award was presented to the University by The Entrepreneurship and Empowerment Initiative of Nigeria (TEEiN), in recognition of Covenant's contributions to entrepreneurship education in Nigeria.

Covenant Emerges Best at United Nations Global People's Summit Best Hub

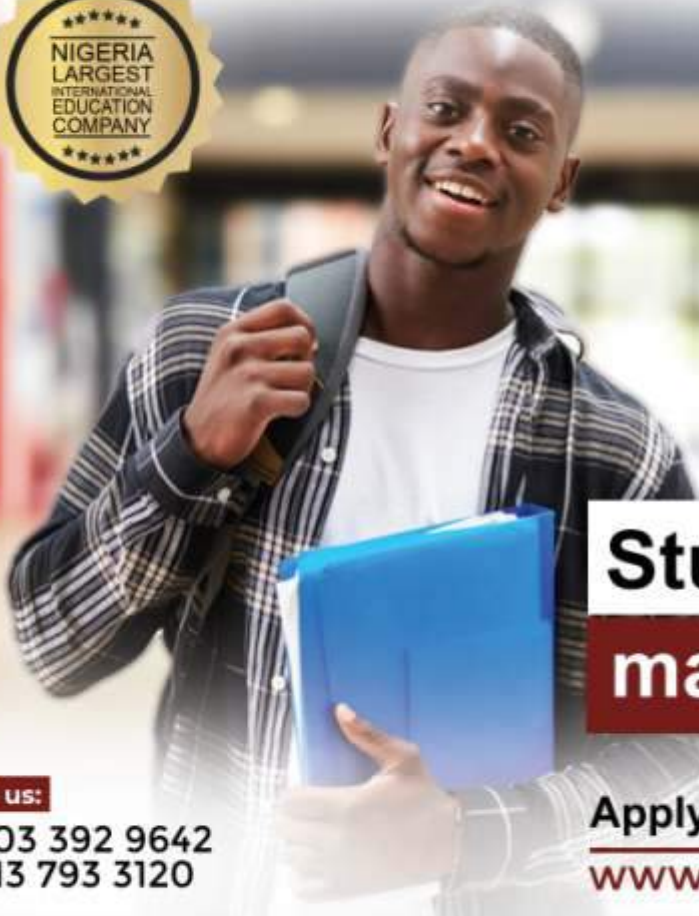
